SUBJECT: 193d Regional Support Group Environmental Statement

1. Here at the 193d Regional Support Group, protecting the environment is one of our highest priorities. 2. The 193 RSG conducts its varied assignments in four separate areas across Pennsylvania in Air Station 1 and Air Station 2. Missions at Air Station 2 include: vehicle operations and maintenance, ground vehicle refueling, heavy construction equipment training, combat communications equipment operations and repair, ground combat training, administrative functions, facility maintenance and repair, grounds maintenance and upkeep, and essential services.
